MUSIC BURSARY

Purpose



Steamboat Mountain Music Society has established this bursary to assist musicians with their musical education and development. These bursary funds may be used for musical

programs of all types: short workshops, music camps, courses, individual or group lessons, master classes, college or university music programs. All forms of music, all types of musical learning aspirations are included: playing technique and theory, composing, performing.

Eligibility

Applicants must live in the Columbia Valley in the region from Canal Flats to Parson. Musicians of all levels will be considered: beginners as well as experienced players of any age may apply.

Application Process

Our application form requires the applicant's name and contact information, as well as a short written proposal statement outlining the goal, timeframe, budget, and other particulars of the educational activity. Further attachments, if appropriate, might include a brief biography of the applicant, a course description, a letter of recommendation from music teacher, and any other documentation the applicant may wish to have considered, to a maximum of 3 further pages.

<u>Timelines</u>

Call for applications will go out in local media and on SMMF website by October 31. Applications must be received no later than December 31. Candidates will be notified in January. Funds awarded through this bursary must be used by the recipient before the end of the following calendar year.

Adjudication

Applications will be adjudicated by directors or appointees of the Steamboat Mountain Music Society. Adjudicators will declare any conflict of interest and absent themselves from any decisions in which their relationship with the applicant will affect their impartiality. In the event of equally strong applications, an interview with the candidates may be required.

Award of Grant

For courses or camps, proof of registration to the course or program will be required. The funding will be released to the applicant in two payments, 80% before the planned educational activity is to begin, and the final 20% instalment after the activity has been completed and reported to the Adjudication Committee. At the time of the award, the applicant will be asked to sign a publicity release, allowing Steamboat Mountain Music Society to use the winner's name and possibly a photo for promotion purposes. The award will be announced in local media and on the SMMF website.

Report Back

A short (250-500 word) written statement about the meaning and outcome of the educational activity must be submitted. When this report has been received, the 20% remainder of the bursary grant shall be released to the applicant.
